Student Achievement:

Goal 1: OPS will increase the percentage of students who are proficient or above in 3rd grade English Language Arts (ELA) as measured by the North Dakota State Assessment (NDSA) ELA from 48% in spring 2022 to 80% in spring 2027.

Goal 2: OPS will increase the percentage of students who are proficient or above in 10th grade math as measured by the North Dakota State Assessment (NDSA) math from 20% in spring 2022 to 65% in spring 2027.

Goal 3. OPS will increase the percentage of students who are Choice Ready as measured by the North Dakota Choice Ready report from 60% in spring 2022 to 95% in spring 2027.
