For Your College Visit

Valuable to get the “feel” of campus, talk to Admissions staff in person, and walk around to see if it has a good fit for you, size and atmosphere. Going with a parent is helpful to get the most out of the experience.

1. Check out their website:
 - a. **Academics** – to find the majors/programs they offer.
 - b. **Admissions** – to find out what the college admission requirements are.
 - c. **Financial Aid** – Costs and fees of attendance, scholarships.
2. Make an appointment with Admissions staff prior to your visit, get parking instructions. Ask to have a tour of a certain department if you have a specific program in mind. This needs to be set up ahead of time.
3. Attend Open Houses – Events the College hosts.
4. Take a Campus Tour – go to Financial Aid, Admissions, Dorms, Library, Career Center, Student Center/Union, and Academic/Tutoring Services, Athletic Department/Recreation Facilities.
5. Eat in the dining hall, observe student life, activities on campus, check out bulletin boards, check out clubs that are offered, sports and intermural activities offered.
