## ESSENTIAL SKILLS

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Earn a North Dakota high school diploma or GED and complete 9-week Career Education/Individual Counseling (15.1-21-18), Financial Literacy (15.1-21-21), pass ND Civics Test (15.1-21-27) and four or more additional indicators:

- 25 hours of Community Service
- 95% Attendance (not counting school related absences)
- Workplace Learning Experience
- Demonstrate competency in 21st century skills
- Successfully complete Capstone project
- Complete any online learning course (A, B, or C)
- Two or more years in organized Co-Curricular Activities
- Two or more years in organized Extra-Curricular Activities

Complete a Four Year Rolling Career Plan, ASVAB score of 31 or greater (varies by branch), Quality Citizenship (No Expulsions/Suspensions), Physically Fit, and two or more additional indicators from the Post-Secondary or Workforce options.
